Stop and go game

How to play

Find some items you can use to make noises – a drum, a wooden spoon and saucepan, a shaker. (If you haven't got any noisemakers, you could use clapping or stamping instead).

Explain that the game is about making noise and listening for when to stop. (minimise explanation for child with language delay, model game also)

Tell your child to make lots of noise until you say, "Stop".

When you say, "Go", they can start again.
