### Workshop Ideas



The following is by no means an exhaustive list, but you may not be able to provide everything all of the time but you can look at useful ways to provide a choice that do not take up too much room; e.g. a vegetable rack, cutlery drainers, in trays etc... A big box on wheels that can roll under the table and can hold recycled material.

- Paper – different sizes and textures, white, coloured, lined and plain.
- Fixing materials – staplers, hole punches, treasury tags, wool, tape.....
- A range of adhesives – glue, paste, glue stick, PVA .....
- Tools – scissors, tape dispensers, rulers, sharpeners.....
- Range of media e.g. pencils, biro, felt pens, gel pens, chalks, charcoal.....
- Storage for in progress and completed work.
- Paints
- Trays, mixing palettes.
- Reclaimed materials
- Brushes – different lengths and thicknesses
- Fabric
- Card – different thickness and sizes.
- Natural and man-made materials.
