

# Early Years Inclusion Team

## Deciding if there is a problem.

- Has the child had time to settle?



Some children may take longer to settle.  
Some may have little experience outside the family.

- What do the parents think?



- Have you thought that poor self-esteem and confidence may be at the root of things?

- Does the child know how to play calmly and socially?  
Adults need to model *how* to play.



- How old is the child? What stage of development is he/she at?  
Sharing and turn taking are acquired skills that take some to develop.



- ❖ When you have more information about the child you can decide if further action is needed. You may want to talk to you Inclusion Coordinator/Area SENCo.
