

DISABILITY ACCESS FUND (DAF)

Your child's nursery/childminder/school can apply for the Disability Access Fund (DAF) if your child is in receipt of Disability Living Allowance (DLA) and the child receives one of the following:



- the universal 15 hours entitlement for 3 and 4-year-olds
or
- the 15 hours entitlement for disadvantaged 2-year-olds
or
- from April 2024, the 15 hours entitlement for children aged 2 years of working parents
or
- from September 2024, the 15 hours entitlement for children aged 9 months to 2 years of working parents

Note: Four-year olds in primary school reception classes are NOT eligible for DAF funding



The Early Years setting will receive

£910* per year

*Revised rate April 2024



This funding will help the setting in making changes to their setting to support your child and other children to access their setting. This may mean small adaptations or special equipment that would help your child



The nursery/childminder/school will need to complete an Application form



You will be asked to complete:

- **A Parental Declaration form**

And

- **Give the setting a copy of your child's Disability Living Allowance (DLA) letter**
