
 We took part in the Your Greenwich, Your Future conference and showed people who came what we do in our ACE groups.

Photos and videos are taken to show the activities and the work we have done.




 We keep a record of our work in photo books which are made every year

12 & 13. The numbers information....




- This year ACE gave 214 views on services for RBG.
- Last year we gave 168 views
- This is 27% more!



- We talked about 12 different topics.
- This is one more than last year



 On average 18 children & young people gave their views on each topic
