 Smaller groups of C&YP are sometimes chosen to give their views on a topic that is important to just them.

 About 60 children & young people aged 7-19 years have regularly taken part.




 We are children & young people with SEND.

We take photos and videos to show the activities and the work we have done.




 We record our views in any way that suits us e.g. drawing, artwork, online, media.

13. The numbers



- This year ACE gave 308 views.
- Last year we gave 214 views. This is 44% more!
- 120% more in the last 4 years!



- We talked about 16 different topics.
- Last year we did 12.
- This is 33% more than last year.



 On average 19 C&YP gave their views on each topic.

14-16. What we did this year....



- 40 of us gave views for the SEND Inspection, some on line.
- 7 of us met with the inspectors who said we were:

<u>"a very special group</u> <u>of young people."</u>



- 31 of us gave views on the "Our Greenwich" plan.
- 14 non-ACE members also gave their views.

<u>"brilliant to have so many."</u>



- 22 of us gave our views on the Short Breaks that RBG offer.
- Last year we had helped to choose these.





20 of us said how to make the Supported Internship Local Offer page better for C&YP.

"brilliant work."




- 10 of us helped to choose the new Head of ASD Outreach Service.
- The person we chose got the job!




- 7 of us gave views on a new building for young people.

- They are including our changes in the design.


<u>"Huge thanks"</u>

We had celebrations too!




- 27 of us planned and prepared our own ACE celebration party.
