Creating artwork to make the SEND Strategy look nice and feel like it is our document.


# RBG asked us to create artwork which would be used in the SEND Strategy document.

- To celebrate the amazing talents of our Young people!










## Who took part?

- 46 ACE group members and 8 extra young people created the artwork.
- The children were of primary, secondary and Post 16 ages and attend 7 schools in Royal Borough of Greenwich.
- The schools are a mix of mainstream, Designated Specialist Provision and specialist provision.
- The children & young people have a range of special educational needs and disabilities.





#### How did we do it?

We created artwork based on the 5 ambitions suggested by children & young people as being important to them:

- We want to be a part of our local community and go to fun activities like everyone else does.
- We want schools and nurseries to support us better and have enough places so we can go to the right school for us.
- We want to be independent and ready for work and/or college when we leave school.
- We want to be as safe and healthy as we can be.
- We want ourselves, our families and friends to understand our needs and be able to support us well.

- Some of us took our artwork to be displayed at the ACE celebration party.
- We thought the artwork looked "cool and amazing".
- The artwork was photographed by a professional photographer.
- Some of the artwork was chosen to go into the SEND Strategy document.
