Greenwich Get Active-SEND Children and Young People

100 Day challenge with the Healthier Greenwich Partnership

The 100-Day Challenge is a project where practitioners and partners across Greenwich come together to collaborate on ideas that will improve physical activity among children and young people (CYP). It hosted teams to co-design potential solutions to trial within the 100-day period with the aim of scaling up those that work. The project was supported by the Healthier Greenwich Partnership.

We had input from local Greenwich schools, Children's Services and community partners such as GLL and Oxleas. The work led to the creation of a Local Offer Page highlighting opportunities in our local area to get active and have fun! We invited young people to share their views on the page and they gave us really helpful ideas to increase their opportunities to get active. Our young people told us they like getting active and that they want more opportunities for playing and exercise every day. As a result we are working on delivering more opportunities for children and young people with SEND, with partnership with GLL.


