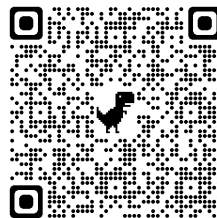

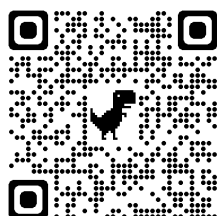

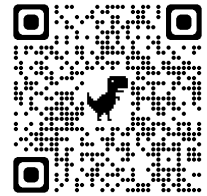
Greenwich Museums - Disability History Month

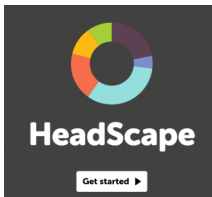

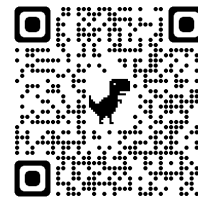


Take care of yourself this Christmas
