


Education, Health & Care Plan Annual Review:



If you have an Education, Health and Care Plan (EHC plan):




It should be reviewed every year.



This is called 'transition planning'.



Your school or college should help you get ready for the review meeting.



You can say:

- What you like and dislike.
- What you want for the future.
- What support is working for you and what is not.




You can ask:

- A parent to come.
- Or someone else who is important to you.



At the review meeting people will talk about:

- What you want to study.
- What work you want to do in the future.
- What help you need to get there.



They will also talk about:

- Help you may need to stay healthy.
- Support you may need to help you make friends and find hobbies.



They will also talk about:

- Help you may need to travel independently.



You can get help to be ready for your annual review.

- If you are not happy with any decisions made.
