- The children & young people have a range of special educational needs and disabilities.



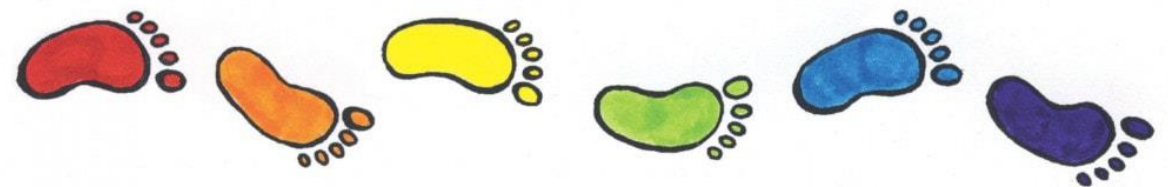
How did we do it?
